Dear Parents.

It is hard to believe it's already time to start planning for next school year! As we have been communicating with families over the past several weeks, it is now time to seek re-enrollment for your student. We have been blessed with another year of strong enrollment, we are seeing our students succeed academically, and are in the process of continuing exciting curriculum initiatives here on campus. I am thankful that you are an intricate part of our Indiana Academy family and a continued supporter of Seventh-day Adventist education.

At Indiana Academy, we believe God has called us to have a high expectation of student responsibility and accountability as it relates to academics, social behavior, and commitment to spiritual growth. Once we have reached capacity either in a particular class or in our residence halls, students will be placed on a general admission waiting list for admission consideration.

I would ask that enrollment at Indiana Academy be a matter of prayerful consideration for you, your student, and the rest of your family. I know that it is a commitment to send your student to Indiana Academy, but I believe it is one that can render immeasurable rewards, not only in the present, but in the hereafter as well. I do want to reiterate however, that while I believe every student *can* benefit from attending Indiana Academy, we may not be the right environment *for* every student.

- Fill out Re-Application and return to Indiana Academy to be considered for re-enrollment.
- Two re-enrollment periods:
 General Acceptance closing on March 31; Late Acceptance closing June 15 (as space is available).
- Once a student is re-accepted, then the General Fee of \$500 (non-refundable) and financial agreement will need to be submitted to reserve your roster spot by: June 15 for **General Acceptance**, and August 1 for **Late Acceptance**.
